IMPORTANT: Please install the software as well as the course material well before the course so you can contact me (peter.vogt@ec.europa.eu) if you have any issues.

Please go to: https://forest.jrc.ec.europa.eu/en/activities/lpa/gtb/ and:

- **1) Install GTB:** Download the <u>GuidosToolbox Installation</u> instructions and the GTB installer for your operating system. Please read the installation instructions *before* running the installer.
- **2) Start GTB**: Press 'OK' to confirm the default data directory. If the application will not start have a look at the operating specific notes in the **GuidosToolbox\_Installation.pdf** or contact me if you still have issues.
- 3) Install Google Earth on your laptop (optional but highly recommended).
- 4) Install the GuidosToolbox WorkShop (GWS) material:
- a) Automatic installation (recommended):

start GTB; from the GTB-menu select Help -> GTB Online -> GWS and follow the instructions.

- b) Manual installation (not recommended, use only if the automatic installation will not work):
- Download the archive GWS<year.month>.zip and copy it into the folder

MS-Windows: GuidosToolbox\guidos\_progs\mspatmp\

OS-X: GuidosToolbox/GuidosToolbox.app/Contents/Resources/idl\*/save\_add/guidos\_progs/mspatmp/

Linux: GuidosToolbox\idl\*\guidos\_progs\mspatmp\

• Open the folder mspatmp, right-click on the zip-archive, and choose to extract the archive. Then open the new extracted folder GWS<year.month> and follow the steps below:

MS-Windows: double-click the file installGWS\_WINDOWS.cmd

OS X: open a terminal (Applications -> Utilities -> Terminal.app) and cd to the folder GWS<year.month>. Then enter (copy/paste) the command: chmod a+x installGWS\_Mac;./installGWS\_Mac

Linux: open a terminal and cd to the folder GWS<year.month>. Then enter (copy/paste) the command:

 $chmod\ a+x\ installGWS\_Linux;./installGWS\_Linux$ 

The workshop presentations GWS[1-4].pptx are now in the directory GuidosToolbox\data\. In the first part of the workshop we will look through GWS[1-3].pptx and in the second part we will work with GWS4.pptx
